The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this minor earthquake was reported as felt in Aguada, Añasco, Juana Díaz, Mayaguez, Moca, Rincón, Río Grande, San Germán, Utuado and Vega Baja, with a maximum intensity of III (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin no damage has been reported and is not expected to occur.
