The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this minor earthquake was reported as felt in Aguada, Cabo Rojo, Guánica, Lajas, Mayaguez and San Germán, with a maximum intensity of IV (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin no damage has been reported and is not expected to occur.
