The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this moderate earthquake was reported as felt in widely throughout Puerto Rico and the Dominican Republic, with a maximum intensity of V (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin no damage has been reported and is not expected to occur.

Based on magnitude, location and historic records the earthquake was not sufficient to generate a tsunami damaging to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands.
