The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this minor earthquake was reported as felt in Aguas Buenas, Caguas, Canóvanas, Carolina, Cidra, Guaynabo, Gurabo, Juncos, San Juan, San Lorenzo, Trujillo Alto and Yabucoa, with a maximum intensity of III (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin the event has not been reported as felt.

Based on magnitude, location and historic records the earthquake was not sufficient to generate a destructive tsunami to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands.
