The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this minor earthquake was reported as felt in Adjuntas, Arecibo, Barranquitas, Bayamón, Carolina, Corozal, Mayaguez and Toa Alta, with a maximum intensity of III (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin no damages has been reported and are not expected to occur.

Based on magnitude, location and historic records the earthquake was not sufficient to generate a destructive tsunami to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands.
