### SEISMIC EVENT/Tsunami

The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this light earthquake was reported as felt in Caguas, Camuy, Corozal, Guaynabo, Gurabo, Humacao, Mayaguez, Moca, Ponce, San Sebastián, Trujillo Alto, Yabucoa and the Virgin Islands, with a maximum intensity of IV (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin no damages has been reported and are not expected to occur.

Based on magnitude, location and historic records the earthquake was not sufficient to generate a destructive tsunami to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands.
