The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this light earthquake was reported as felt in Añasco, Cataño, Lares, Maricao, Mayaguez and Moca, with a maximum intensity of III (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin the event has not been reported as felt.

Based on magnitude, location and historic records the earthquake was not sufficient to generate a destructive tsunami to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands.
