The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this moderate earthquake was reported as felt in widely throughout Puerto Rico, with a maximum intensity of VI (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin no damages has been reported, but given the size and location this can not be ruled out.

Based on magnitude, location and historic records the earthquake was not sufficient to generate a destructive tsunami to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands.
