The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this moderate earthquake was reported as felt in the Central region of Puerto Rico, the Northern region of Puerto Rico and the Western region of Puerto Rico, with a maximum intensity of IV (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin no damages has been reported and are not expected to occur.

Based on magnitude, location and historic records the earthquake was not sufficient to generate a destructive tsunami to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands.
