The Puerto Rico Seismic Network (PRSN) received information that this light earthquake was reported as felt in St. Thomas and the Eastern region of Puerto Rico, with a maximum intensity of IV (Modified Mercalli Scale, MM). At the moment of generating this bulletin no damages has been reported, but given the size and location this can not be ruled out.

Based on magnitude, location and historic records the earthquake was not sufficient to generate a destructive tsunami to Puerto Rico and Virgin Islands.
