Quake joits P.R.; no damage noted

A quake measuring 4.9 on the Richter Scale was located 40 to 60 miles west of Puerto Rico Monday afternoon, University of Puerto Rico seismologists reported.

The tremor was detected at 3:46 p.m. at latitude 18 and longitude 69.1, and was felt by some people in the Mayaguez area, according to the University of Puerto Rico Mayaguez Campus, Department of Geology. No damages were reported.
